Entry Fee: \$5.00

- **DEADLINE FOR ENTRY FORM JUNE 29, 2018**

- **Receiving dates:** Monday-Friday, June 25-29 from 8am-4pm. Bottles of beer, with ID label attached, to be delivered to ND State Fair, Attn: Judging – AHA Competition, 2005 Burdick Expy E, Minot ND 58701.
- The North Dakota State Fair Homebrew competition is an American Homebrewers Association (A.H.A) sanctioned event. The Mead and Cider divisions will not be sanctioned.
- Open to amateur brewers throughout the United States and Canada.
- Submit two 12oz. bottles per entry. You can only submit one entry per class, but you can submit entries in multiple classes within a division.
- Bottles must be free of commercial labels, residue, or any identifying marks (preprinted caps must be colored over with black ink). Judges may refuse to judge entries that do not meet these criteria.
- Attach a label to each bottle with a rubber band (no tape or glue). Entry form and labels available at [www.ndstatefair.com/exhibit](http://www.ndstatefair.com/exhibit) which have spaces for brewer information, class, division, special ingredient information and the phrase “not for sale.”
- All entries become property of the ND State Fair. Bottles will not be returned to participants.
- Exhibits will not be released before 6pm on the last day. Exhibits may be picked up on Saturday, July 28 between the hours of 6pm and 8pm, or on Sunday, July 29 between the hours of 10am and 2pm. Those picking up exhibits on Saturday, July 28 must pay gate admission.
- First, Second and Third place ribbons to be awarded along with a plaque for Best of Show in each division.
