

North Dakota State Fair Cornhole Tournament Rules and Regulations

Welcome to the annual North Dakota State Fair Cornhole Tournament! This event is designed to give fairgoers competitive fun and a chance to win great prizes. Please read the following rules and regulations carefully.

1. Eligibility

- Open to all ages. Participants under 18 must have a guardian's consent.
- Participants must be pre-registered to participate.
- Each team consists of 2 players, with no substitutions allowed after the first game has begun.

2. Registration

- Entry fee per team: \$100.
- Pre-registration is required. The deadline is midnight, July 24, 2024.
- Registration is done exclusively on Score Holio app. Download the app on your mobile device, scan the QR Code, register and pay.

3. Equipment and Setup

- The organizers will provide official cornhole boards.
- Boards will be placed 27 feet apart, from front edge to front edge.
- Participants can use the bags provided; while supplies last or use their bags.

4. Game Play

5.1 Basic Rules

- A coin flip will decide the first throw.
- Teams alternate throws, one bag per turn, until all 8 bags are played.
- The game is played in a Race to 21 points, with cancellation, no bust rule.
- You must stand directly in front of your partner on the opposite side.

5.2 Scoring

- Bags in the hole score 3 points; bags on the board score 1 point.
- Scores are calculated at the end of each inning, with only one team scoring per inning based on the difference in points.
- Bags knocked off the board by an opponent's throw or those touching the ground are not scored.

5.3 Conduct

- Players must remain behind the front edge of the cornhole board during throws.
- Courtesy and sportsmanship are expected at all times.

6. Tournament Structure

- The tournament will follow a double-elimination format.
- A random draw will determine brackets before the tournament starts.

7. Prizes

7.1 Payouts – 100% PAYOUT minus any fees

- First Place: TBD number of entries, plus a champion plaque for each team member, plus two tickets to Thomas Rhett on Friday, July 26, 2024.
- Second Place: TBD number of entries, plus a plaque for each team member.
- Third Place: TBD number of entries, plus a plaque for each team member.

7.2 Plaques

- Custom plaques will be awarded to the top three teams, featuring the event's name, year, and the team's placement.

8. General

- Decisions made by the tournament officials are final.
- The organizers reserve the right to change the rules, format, or other tournament details as necessary.
- All players agree to abide by these rules and regulations by participating.
