RULES REGARDING ENTRIES:

- Entries will close **July 6 at 5pm**. Our online entry system can be found on ndstatefair.com. For a step-by-step please see page 12.
- Only entries received by the July 6 deadline will be listed on the show program and receive their passes in the mail, if any were requested. Any entry after the deadline that requested passes, the passes can be picked up at the NDSF office prior to fair or at Gate F during the fair.
- Entries may be made after the deadline by paying triple the normal fees. **Entries will not be received after 5pm on Friday, July 10.**
- If five paid entries in one breed have not been received by check-in deadline, livestock will be required to show in the other breeds division.
- Base date for age is July 6, 2026
- Only two entries in the individual rings will be accepted from any exhibitor. Premiums are paid on only 2 entries per class. Any class containing over 24 head shall be split by birthdate.
- All animals must have association registration papers. Photocopies will not be accepted. All registration papers must be presented when the animals are checked in at the Expo Barn Office. All entries must be made in the name of the exhibitor and must be bona fide property of the exhibitor.
- All animals must have an **official** ear tag (scrapie tag), written tags will not be permitted.
- Specify special stalling needs on entry forms. Late entries have no stall guarantees. No exhibitor will be granted a "tack stall" until all animals are housed and if room is available. Exhibitor is responsible for providing divider panels if necessary to separate animals.
- Youth may not show the same animal in 4-H & FFA, but may show the same animal in the open show.
- **Fan Policy: No fans, fan stands, or butt fans of any type will be allowed in the barn aisles.**

RULES REGARDING SPECIE SCHEDULE & BARN:

- All goats must be penned by 11am Tuesday, July 21. No early arrivals or releases. Release time will be 6pm on Saturday, July 25. Removal of open class animals before 6pm on departure day will result in forfeiture of all premiums.
- Livestock trailers and livestock vehicles will be required to park off grounds. Camper vehicle can park in assigned camping lot with appropriate pass. All vehicles used to transport livestock and/or RV's must have a valid auto pass. Vehicles without passes will be towed at the owner's expense. Vehicle passes must be requested in advance of the first day of Fair, and will not be available at the gate. Livestock load/unload passes will be limited to one (1) per family and can be requested on the livestock entry form. These passes will only be used to load/unload livestock and tack during entry and release times. Tack stored off grounds can only be unloaded from 6:00AM to 10:00AM and 7:00PM to 9:00PM. - This is an official ADGA sanctioned show and their rules shall govern. If you do not have a copy of Rules Governing the Conduct of Official Shows, write the North Dakota State Fair for a copy. This is a separately sanctioned Junior and Senior Show. In order to make the show run smoothly, the show order is subject to change. Both the junior doe and senior does shows will have a best in show.
- The open buck and 4-H/FFA shows are non-sanctioned.
